## **“Built on the original Mayflower Steps”**

Mayflower, Voyage of the Pilgrim Fathers  
The Pilgrim Fathers left from the old port of  
Plymouth in 1620 in a small sailing ship, the  
Mayflower. Their departure point & last  
point of contact with the ‘Old World’, (The  
Mayflower Steps), are now buried  
somewhere below where the Admiral  
MacBride pub now stands.

Sutton Harbour was then a little larger than it  
is today, and the waterline would have run  
along roughly where the road now is, in front  
of the historical island house, (now an ice-  
cream parlour), and up to the ‘steps’ which  
would have protruded from the vertical  
rocks behind the pub.

The Pilgrim Fathers stay in Plymouth was for  
10 days. They were made very welcome by  
the local people who were sympathetic to  
their cause. So impressed by this welcome  
and what was done for them they named  
their first settlement in the New World  
“Plymouth” (Massachusetts)
